



Scholarships awarded by the South African Association of Botanists

Each year the South African Association of Botanists awards a maximum of two "SAAB Scholarships", to a SADEC graduate with 70% or above grade average. The R10 000 scholarships are awarded for 1 year of tertiary study at Honours level (or 4th year level of study) in any botanical field in Sciences or Agricultural Sciences. The successful applicant should study at a South African institution and should become an active member of SAAB.

How to apply

Please include with application:

1. Curriculum Vitae with names of two referees
2. A letter of motivation from your honours/4th year project supervisor, who should be a paid-up member of SAAB.
3. Certified academic transcript
4. One page motivation, including a description of your honours/ 4th year research interests
5. Name(s) of other bursaries/scholarships applied for and amount
6. Application deadline: 15 February.

Successful candidates will be notified in February of the year of the award.
